INTIMACY

READ

Colossians 1:19-23

For God was pleased to have all his fullness dwell in him, and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through his blood, shed on the cross. Once you were alienated from God and were enemies in your minds because of [a] your evil behavior. But now he has reconciled you by Christ's physical body through death to present you holy in his sight, without blemish and free from accusation—if you continue in your faith, established and firm, and do not move from the hope held out in the gospel. This is the gospel that you heard and that has been proclaimed to every creature under heaven, and of which I, Paul, have become a servant.

ENGAGE

For God was pleased to have all his fullness dwell in him, and through him to reconcile to himself all things, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by making peace through his blood, shed on the cross.

Colossians 1:19-20

Through Christ we gain access to God. At one time we were separated from God because of sin, but Jesus' crucifixion dealt with our fallen nature and made us new.

What does it mean to be reconciled to God?

If you continue in your faith, established and firm, and do not move from the hope held out in the gospel. This is the gospel that you heard and that has been proclaimed to every creature under heaven, and of which I, Paul, have become a servant. Colossians 1:23

Jesus' death also gave us access to have a direct and personal relationship with God. We no longer need a priest or prophet to speak on our behalves.

What have we been given access to in God through Christ?

The LORD would speak to Moses face to face, as one speaks to a friend. Then Moses would return to the camp, but his young aide Joshua son of Nun did not leave the tent. Exodus 33:11

Because of the intensity of God's glory Moses was not allowed to see God's face or it would kill him, yet this passage says that, "Moses met with God face-to-face, as one speaks with a friend."

What does it mean to meet with God face-to-face?

Follow up question: True intimacy is reconciliation, access, and face-to-face interaction. How can we apply this biblical principle to our daily lives and relationships?
